

Missouri Angus Auxiliary Queen Program

The Missouri Angus Queen and Princess program is supported by the Missouri Angus Auxiliary. The Missouri Angus Queen and Princess opportunity was designed in an effort to create a program that supports the growth and education of young women in Missouri who are involved in the production and/or promotion of Angus cattle.

The Missouri Angus Queen and Princess will be selected and announced in June at the Missouri Angus Preview Show, Sedalia, MO. Applicants should be available for interviews prior to the announcement during the Sunday show.

Following are the eligibility requirements for Missouri Angus Queen:

- Applicants must currently be a member of the Missouri Junior Angus Association.
- Applicants must be 16 – 21 years of age.
- Applicants must be involved in the Angus business and show a commitment to the promotion of Angus cattle.
- Applicants must be residents of the state of Missouri.
- Applicants must commit to attend the following events:

Missouri Angus Preview, Sedalia, MO (June), **(In the year of application, the Queen is expected to work the Open Show on Sunday. At the close of her term the following year, the Queen is expected to be present at the interview process and work the Jr. Angus shows on Saturday.)**

Ozark Empire Fair, Springfield, MO (August)

Missouri State Fair, Sedalia, MO (August)

American Royal Livestock Show, Kansas City, MO (October)

Missouri Angus Futurity (February)

Optional shows/events include the National Junior Angus Show (July).

- Applicants must include with their application: one wallet size portrait (school) photo, one candid photo of involvement in an Angus activity and one candid photo showing involvement in a school or community activity.
- The Missouri Angus Queen will be required to submit a brief article to each issue of the Missouri Junior Angus Association newsletter, describing their most recent experiences related to their role of The Missouri Angus Queen.
- The Missouri Angus Queen will be required to submit a brief written report to the Missouri Angus Auxiliary 1st Vice-President following participation at each required event.
- **Failure to comply with any of the above requirements may lead to forfeiture of some or all of the scholarship monies at the discretion of the Royalty/Ambassador committee of the Missouri Angus Auxiliary.**

The Missouri Angus Auxiliary will provide the Missouri Angus Queen with the following:

- \$150.00 clothing allowance
- Round trip mileage (25 cents per mile) for each of the required events
- A \$50 lodging allowance for one night's stay at each required event if needed
- A \$1000 college scholarship will be awarded to the Queen if duties are completely fulfilled and approved. The scholarship will be awarded with proof of enrollment to an approved institution of higher education. (In such a case the Queen is a high school undergraduate, the scholarship award will be banked by the Auxiliary until college entry)

Reimbursement for the above mentioned expenses requires a mileage log and receipts. Reimbursement for expenses will be made at the end of one's reign.

The Missouri Angus Queen is to conform to the official dress code of Miss American Angus. Skirts, dress slacks, blazers, dresses, riding boots and or dress shoes are most appropriate. Hats are NOT allowed. Jeans are NOT allowed unless the queen is showing cattle, in which case only black or khaki jeans are appropriate.
