 - A Health Certificate within 30-days of the show is REQUIRED to show!
 - Addition of a Phenotype/Genotype Heifer Show (PGS)!

 - Potential to show an Angus heifer 4 times in one weekend!!

Fitting Rule: Full fit optional, but no paint allowed.

Fitting Rule: Tops, tailheads and tails only, no paint! *Excludes cattle competing in MCA Supreme Drive!

Frequently Asked Questions

1. The Showman App? We are trying it out this year and excited for the various features it offers including allowing our members to pay via credit card. Please note, it is a website, not an app.
2. To show on Friday in the Missouri Angus Phenotype/Genotype (PGS) Heifer Show, you need to pay your entry fees (\$25 per head). You can enter online on the Showman App OR use the paper form with submission to Missouri Angus. No late entries!
3. To show on Saturday in the MCA All-Breeds Show, you need to pay your entry fees (\$30 per head) and membership dues to the Missouri Junior Cattlemen's Association (\$10). Additionally, you must pay the \$10 bedding fee per head with entry fees. Completed entries with payment can be done at Showman App OR www.mocattle.org OR with a paper form submitted to MCA.
4. To show on Sunday in the MO Angus Open Preview Show, you need to pay your entry fees (\$25 per head) and membership dues to Missouri Angus Association (\$45) and/or Missouri Junior Angus Association (\$15). Mail entries to the Missouri Angus Association in Holden, MO OR pay with your MCA entries for junior members OR submit on the Showman App. \$10 per head bedding fees for open only cattle also apply. Memberships can be paid with entry or at check-in on Friday in the Coliseum.
5. The Missouri Angus Association Breeder Jackpot Show is for heifers and steers purchased from a Missouri Angus Association member. Bred-and-Owned cattle are not eligible. To show, registration paper must read that the 1st Owner (and/or Breeder) is the Missouri Angus Association member. Exhibitors must pay the \$20 per head entry fee. Additionally, the breeder must pay a nomination fee per head of \$50 for private treaty sale or \$20 if nominated in advance of a qualifying Missouri Angus sale. Entries can be completed on the Showman App OR by paper copy and mailed to Missouri Angus Association at 634 SW 1201st Road, Holden, MO 64040. Please note, the show has been moved from Sunday afternoon to Friday evening.
