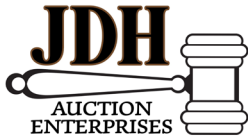

Ladies of Autumn will be strictly a live female sale; frozen genetics will not be offered. If you would like to consign any frozen lots, the Missouri Angus Futurity will provide that opportunity.

As stated earlier in this letter, this is an elite female sale. Consignments should consist of open and bred heifers, cow/calf pairs, bred cows, and donors. I would like to challenge each breeder to dig deep into their respective herds and consign females that will make this the prestigious event it was designed to be. Cattle will be screened for both the Ladies of Autumn and the Futurity by the sale manager. Herd visits and screening have already begun. Cattle consigned to both sales must be genomically tested. Please submit DNA on all potential consignments as soon as possible, as turnaround time for results can be lengthy.
