

Missouri Angus Auxiliary Queen Program



The Missouri Angus Queen Program is conducted by the Missouri Angus Auxiliary. The program supports the growth and education of young women in Missouri who are involved in the production and/or promotion of Angus cattle. The selection process occurs annually in February at the Missouri Angus Futurity Weekend in Columbia, MO. Applicants should be available for interviews prior to the announcement during the annual banquet.

Following are the eligibility requirements for Missouri Angus Queen:

- Applicants must currently be a member of the Missouri Junior Angus Association.
- Applicants must be 16 – 21 years of age.
- Youth may serve up to two years as Queen which do not need to be consecutive. Former royalty would need to re-apply.
- Applicants must be involved in the Angus business and show a commitment to the promotion of Angus cattle.
- Applicants must be residents of the state of Missouri.
- Applicants must commit to attend the following events:
 - Missouri Angus Futurity Weekend, Columbia, MO (February)
 - Missouri Angus Preview Show Weekend, Sedalia, MO (June)
 - Missouri State Fair Angus Shows, Sedalia, MO (August)
 - American Royal Angus Shows, Kansas City, MO (October)
 - Optional shows/events include:
 - National Junior Angus Show, Location Rotates Annually (July)
 - Ozark Empire Fair Angus Shows, Springfield, MO (July)
- The Missouri Angus Queen will be required to submit a brief biography written in third person after being crowned for the Missouri Angus Trails.
- At the conclusion of her term, the Missouri Angus Queen will be required to provide a verbal report at the Missouri Angus Auxiliary Annual Meeting term. If not able to attend, the report can be a written and submitted to the 1st Vice President.
- **Failure to comply with any of the above requirements may lead to forfeiture of some or all of the scholarship monies at the discretion of the Missouri Angus Auxiliary Executive Board.**

The Missouri Angus Auxiliary will provide the Missouri Angus Queen with the following:

- A tiara and a \$150 clothing allowance.
- Round trip mileage (25 cents per mile) for each of the required events.
- A \$50 lodging allowance for one night's stay at each required event if needed.
- A \$1,000 college scholarship will be awarded to the Queen if duties are completely fulfilled and approved. The scholarship will be awarded with proof of enrollment to an institution of higher education. (In such a case the Queen is a high school student, the scholarship award will be banked by the Auxiliary until college entry).

Reimbursement for the above-mentioned expenses requires a mileage log and receipts.
Reimbursement for expenses will be made at the end of one's reign.

The Missouri Angus Queen is to conform to the following dress code: Skirts, dress slacks, blazers, dresses, riding boots and or dress shoes are most appropriate. Hats are NOT allowed. Jeans are NOT allowed unless the queen is showing cattle, in which case only black or khaki jeans are appropriate.
